## 1. Transnational PP workshop on EDIT VALUE (WP3)

On day 1 (4<sup>th</sup> of November 2013) Enviros ran with the support of STENUM a full training session on the EDIT

After an introduction into the EDIT tool and an overview of its methodology, STENUM presented a virtual SME case for analysis (from the dairy sector).

Based on this virtual case the group of trainees was split up into 3 separate working groups in order to exercise the different steps of the EDIT methodology on the virtual case:

- Initial stakeholder analysis (interactive exercise with form 1.1)
- Input-output analysis (interactive exercise with form 1.2)
- Indicative life cycle analysis (interactive exercise with form 1.3)
- Quantification of potentials
- Identification of potentials within an enterprise (interactive exercise with form 1.4 selected aspects only)







#### Next steps and deadlines WP3

- A number of issues were raised during the training session and will be incorporated into the further refinement of the EDIT tool and the preparation of the training material for the first external training session in Prague (5<sup>th</sup> & 6<sup>th</sup> of February 2014).
- With view to the external training workshop it was agreed that every partner that is piloting the EDIT tool (i.e. STENMUM, ProAkademia, Enviros and ENEA) shall nominate 3-4 trainers (incl. trainers from the partner institution themselves) by the **end of November 2013**.
- For finalizing the country reports on existing tools remember to use the PRESOURCE CI (cover page, logos, a preface etc.) as circulated
- Furthermore it was agreed that these 4 partners that are running the piloting of the EDIT tool shall have secured the confirmation from at least 2 SMEs that they will participate in the piloting of the EDIT tool by 5<sup>th</sup> of February 2014.
- Corvinus University and UBA are currently considering to participate also in the piloting of the EDIT tool.

#### **Analytical Reports on Market and Stakeholder Analysis**

## Next steps and deadlines WP4 (Analytical Reports)

For the remaining country reports it was agreed that they should be submitted to Fraunhofer MOEZ by **30 November 2013** in order to allow enough time for Fraunhofer MOEZ to compile the synthesis report No. 1 "Institutional barriers and drivers for financing eco-innovation".







#### **Cost Benefit Approach**

The Cost Benefit Approach (CBA) should be a product that is used by the companies and the financial stakeholders. For this purpose it should be an easy to use indicator system that allows to optimize the decision-making processes of eco-innovation/RE investments.

#### Next steps and deadlines WP4 (CBA)

- Furthermore it was discussed how the CBA could be combined with the EDIT VALUE tool. As a first and quick solution it was agreed that the EDIT VALUE tool should be complemented by another form. Enviros will draft such a template by **early December 2013**, which then can be discussed at the Transnational Workshop in Berlin among MOEZ an Enviros.
- As lessons learnt from other projects it was also discussed whether core outputs (like e.g. the CBA or the financial guideline for SMEs under this WP4 but of course also the EDIT VALUE under WP3) could receive a extra go in terms of design / layout as this would increase considerably the outreach. UBA stated that they would review their budget to see whether they could unlock some funds for doing so.

#### **Competence Platform**

VDI presented the current status of the competence platform.

It was agreed that input from the project partners to the platform (the format for submitting this info is available in the internal section of the PRESOURCE website) would follow the following intervals:

- Calendar / event section: There should be a minimum of 1 new event per week, i.e. every partner should submit at least every 8 weeks information on a new event
- Documents / publication section: There should be a minimum of 1 new RE document / publication per week, i.e. every partner should submit information at least every 8 weeks. Whereas the documents / publications can also be in national languages the information abstract for the website should always be in English.
- Good practice examples: There should be a minimum of 1 good practice example per month, i.e. every partner should submit at least every 8 months information on a good practice example

## 4. Management & Reporting

- PR1&2 was submitted in late Sep 2013
- 2 clarification rounds have been performed, it is likely that the report will be final approved before Christmas 2014
- The JTS pointed out on a number of occasions (refers to WP3, WP4 and WP5) that the
  reports shall obey the publication requirements of the PRESOUCE project / CE Programme
  and should fulfil a number of minimum requirements in order to be acceptable (e.g. cover
  page, preface, summary). This has been stipulated having in mind that the CE Programme is
  publishing these reports in their project library
- All partners that didn't or couldn't report this time (or reported only for period 1) are asked to ensure that they will provide their certified FLC documents for the upcoming reporting period 3

#### Next steps and deadlines WP1 (Reporting)

- Period 3 runs from 1<sup>st</sup> of June 2013 to 30<sup>th</sup> of November 2013
- Partners shall submit their filled-in templates by 15<sup>th</sup> of December to EPCO / s.Pro:
  - o Template on activity reporting (with a special focus on the indicators)
  - Template to financial reporting (with a link between the cost items per budget line and the breakdown of expenditures to be completed by each FLC). This template is circulated by EPCO after the approval of PR1&2
