#### Lessons learnt I

- ✓ The international approach of knowledge exchange can be very beneficial.
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- ✓ Instruments and activities have to be adapted to the regional and local context.
- ✓ Good communication and target group oriented information services are crucial precondition for success.





#### Lessons learnt II







- ✓ Early planning and invitation crucial.
- ✓ Give international experts an active role to ensure participation, while main targets groups are national experts. → Rotating workshops in different countries very beneficial for exchange.
- ✓ Interactive formats of workshops could be further strengthened.
